Dear Child Care Provider:

We are pleased to let you know that starting **today**, **Monday**, **January 11**, **2021**, child care workers are <u>eligible</u> to receive the COVID-19 vaccine. Please share this information with your staff.

Where are the vaccination sites, and how do I make an appointment?

Find a vaccination location and make an appointment here: <u>nyc.gov/vaccinefinder</u>

All of the appointment slots were booked. What should I do?

Vaccine supply is in high demand, and appointments will fill up. New locations and appointment slots will be added regularly, so keep checking!

Will I have to pay for the vaccine?

No. There is no cost to be vaccinated.

What will I need to bring to my appointment?

- When you make your appointment, you will receive directions about an intake form and any proof of employment to bring with you.
- Please wear a face covering to the vaccination site. You will not be permitted to enter without one.
- If you have health insurance, you may be asked to bring your insurance card.
- If you are not feeling well on the day of your appointment, please reschedule.

Will I be fully vaccinated after my first vaccine?

No. The vaccines currently available require two doses.

How can I find out more about the vaccine?

Read this <u>fact sheet</u> to learn more about the COVID-19 vaccine, which has been shown to be safe and effective.

Can I stop wearing a face covering and physical distancing after being vaccinated?

No. We do not have enough information to say if or when it will be safe to stop wearing face coverings and physical distancing. Until we understand more about the protection that COVID-19 vaccines provide, everyone must continue to practice the key prevention measures.

Is the vaccine required by the Health Code?

The Health Code does not mandate the COVID-19 vaccination, but the NYC Health Department encourages all New Yorkers to be vaccinated.

Thank you for everything you do to reduce the risk of COVID-19 transmission in NYC. Share this flyer on <u>vaccines</u>, and keep doing what we know works - before and after vaccination:

Stay home, especially when sick or if you've traveled or been exposed to COVID-19

- Wash your hands
 Wear a face covering whenever you're outside your house
 Remain six feet apart
- Get tested
