All programs are regulated by the Department of Health and our 4-year-old program is a Pre-K for All, funded by the Department of Education. The director acts as a liaison for these agencies. Approximately 200 students attend the Early Childhood programs.

The Educational Director supports a creative team of educators, and ensures the maintenance of compliance of regulatory agencies, and encourages a rigorous curriculum centered on student needs. Organization is a must! Family and community outreach, as well as an enthusiastic attitude toward work and coworkers, is the key to success in this position. The Educational Director meets weekly with the other directors to share and learn strategies for improving program. These weekly meetings are also a time to celebrate success and build managerial relationships!
