- Sanitizes equipment and ensures room is clean, presentable and safe.

- Setups of child appropriate and child friendly music to accompany the children during this time.
- Conforms to the Prospect Park YMCA's standards and guidelines and participates in necessary trainings.
- Adhere to all Department of Health, YMCA of Greater New York, and funder standards, expectations, and regulations.
- Actively participate in the training sessions, designated meetings and special events.
