The core of afterschool programming focuses on literacy, STEM, and the arts. Some projects that have been done in the past are creative writing, urban gardening, and robotics. This is an excellent position for a college student or professional interested in working with K-12 aged students in a unique, eclectic, and mission-driven environment.
