Teacher Responsibilities:

- Promote children's development and learning through the implementation of a developmentally appropriate virtual based curriculum for families and children through virtual weekly classes
- Recruit children for the Early Head Start Program; working with their families on goal planning; completing strengths and needs assessments; providing community referrals and resources; planning and conducting two virtual socializations' per month
- Encourage and support parental involvement in the virtual visits, group experiences and all other opportunities offered by the program

- Home Visitor CDA, Family Development Credential or Infant/Toddler CDA OR Minimum of 12
 Early Childhood Education credits with-in an AAS Degree program
- Must possess knowledge of Infant/Toddler child development and family interaction
- Ability to communicate effectively, both verbally and in writing
- Experience working with diverse populations
- A clean and valid NYS Driver's License

If not already in place, CEO will assist the candidate for this position in obtaining their Home Visitor Child Development Associate (CDA) or Family Development Credential (FDC) within the first year of employment.
