Responsibilities

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- Develop individualized curricula that work with each child to ensure no one falls behind
- Deliver lessons and perform activities
- Coach and co-teach with assistants, aides, and classroom volunteers
- Meet with parents to report on their childâ€[™]s performance, progress
- reports, and sometimes help non-English-speaking parents
- Monitor and report developmental concerns: behavioral, educational, and developmental progress
- Lead staff meetings and keep staff updated on policy and regulation changes
- Respond to emergency situations, such as first aid and conflict management
- Teaching and following a daily routine.

- Hold CPR and basic emergency first aid certification
- Plan each day so children have the opportunity to express themselves,
- Develop basic social skills, and learn the rudiments of elementary subjects.
