Job Description

The Professional Development Program (PDP) of the University at Albany's Rockefeller College seeks a service-minded individual who is committed to performing high-quality work to fill a Senior Trainer position in PDP's Early Childhood Education and Training Program in Albany, NY.

DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES:

Under the direction of the Department Manager or designee, this position performs as a valuable team member in the Professional Development Program - Early Childhood Education and Training Program. The Senior Trainer serves as a master trainer and for the delivery of in-person classroom and virtual classroom/online education and training programs for the NYS Office of Children and Family Services Division of Child Care Services. Topics include, but are not limited to: NYS Statute, Regulations, Policies, and quality programming for child care services. The Senior Trainer participates in the planning and development of training delivery plans and curricula for a variety of performance-based training, including updating, maintaining, and developing instructional materials. The Senior Trainer will perform research for and assist in the design of curriculum, related materials, and visual aids. Job responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Deliver a variety of performance-based curricula and educational materials for web-based and classroom deliveries throughout NYS.
- Review and update training curriculum and materials for compliance with applicable Office of Children and Family Services (OCFS) and State University of New York (SUNY) regulations and policies.

- Collaborate with PDP management/staff and sponsor staff to improve/expand a project/functional area through developing new resources, programs, or other opportunities.
- Assist in needs assessments and program evaluation and analysis.
- Complete project reports and documentation as required.
- Other duties as assigned to meet contractual obligations.
