
Qualifications:Â

- Associate's Degree in Early Childhood, Child Development, or related field, with one year of experience with infants and toddlersÂ
- 2. Infant and Toddler Child Care and Education Credential, Infant Toddler Child Development Associate Credential, or another credential specific to infant/toddler care, with two years of experience working with young childrenÂ

- 3. Child Development Associate Credential with two years of experience in child care, with at least one year caring for infants or toddlersÂ
- 4. 9 college credits in Early Childhood, Child Development, or a related field, and a documented plan to complete a credential or degree in infant/toddler care, with two years of experience in child care, including one year with infants or toddlersÂ
- Minimum Education Level: Some College Credits
- Preferred Education Level: CDA Credential (with credit-bearing certificate)
