- -Provide individualized attention and support to support the unique needs of each child.
- -Model positive behavior and teach conflict resolution and social skills.
- ** Safety and Supervision**
- -Maintain a safe and hygienic environment by adhering to health safety regulations.
- -Supervise children at all times, both indoors and outdoors, to ensure their well-being and prevent accidents.
- -Follow emergency procedures and protocols, in the event of illness, injury, or other emergencies.
- **Parent Communication**
- -Establish and maintain open, ongoing communication with parents, and caregivers regarding their child's progress, behavior and needs.
- -Provide regular updates, and feedback through verbal communication, written reports, and parent- teacher conferences.
- -Collaborate with parents to address any concerns or challenges and develop strategies for supporting their child's development.

- -Seek feedback and reflect on teaching practices to continuously improve the quality of care and instruction provided to children.
