Responsibilities

- Assists the UPK Teacher with preparation, implementation and evaluation of the classroom activities and curriculum as a whole as well as specific activities.
- Cares for children's physical needs, which may involve lifting and carrying very young children if necessary.
- Assists in maintaining an environment that is safe, healthy, orderly and appealing.
- Shares with the UPK Teacher observations and insights relating to specific children in the group.
- Alerts the UPK Teacher to children with special needs, to problems, incidents and emergencies to ensure appropriate intervention is taken.
- Develops and maintains a cooperative working relationship with UPK students' parents and guardians.
- Assists in planning and implementing educational and recreational activities that meet varying student needs.
- Provides classroom instruction in the absence of the Teacher
- Reports to the UPK Teacher the need for supplies, materials, equipment and repairs.
- Participates effectively in supervisory conferences and staff meetings
