Job Description

The Professional Development Program (PDP) of the University at Albany's Rockefeller College seeks a service-minded individual who is committed to performing high-quality work to fill a Senior Education Specialist position in PDP's Child Care Assistance Program and Regulated Care Training located in Albany, NY.

DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES:

This position is part of a dynamic team of professionals at the Professional Development Program responsible for creating innovative educational programs and materials and delivering high-quality training for adult professionals working in the Child Care Assistance Program and the enrollment of Legally Exempt Child Care Providers. This role entails travel across the diverse regions of New York State (NYS), offering a unique opportunity to engage with a variety of communities. Job duties include, but are not limited to:

- Develop and refine curricula tailored to the specific needs of the training audience, ensuring it aligns with PDP adult learning standards and NYS rules, regulations, and policies.
- Deliver top-tier training sessions to project participants, utilizing both classroom settings and virtual platforms, ensuring quality adult learning experiences, and compliance with applicable NYS laws, regulations, and policies.
- Provide comprehensive technical assistance to training participants, offering timely support for any follow-up queries and guiding them through complex concepts or processes.
- Evaluate the impact of training initiatives and implement strategies for continuous improvement when necessary.
- Engage and collaborate with PDP management/staff and project sponsors to refine and advance current initiatives, while also identifying and developing new opportunities for

participants' learning enhancement and professional growth.

- Execute thorough administrative tasks including post-event documentation, travel logistics, and participate in the compilation of periodic reports to maintain organizational efficiency and accountability.
- Other duties as assigned to meet contractual obligations.
