Job Description

- Engage in active play with children; this often means getting down on the floor to interact with them

- Assist in providing activities and opportunities that encourage curiosity, exploration, and problem solving appropriate to the development levels of the children
- · Attend to the personal hygiene of each child in your care, including changing diapers or soiled clothing and washing hands
- Keeping a clean and well-kept classroom at all times
- · Maintain a safe environment based on safety standards set by the Center and state guidelines
- Work cooperatively and effectively as a team member by communicating and contributing information on a continuous basis
- · Maintain open, friendly, and cooperative relationship with each child's family and encourage their involvement in the program
- Continue professional development through attending workshops, conferences, and other staff development opportunities
- Consistently assist lead teacher with daily tasks and activities

Other Responsibilities and Duties:

- · Perform duties as planned for the assigned classroom
- · Assist in maintaining accurate and appropriate records for children in the assigned classroom
- · Help other staff in preparing meals for children as required
- Demonstrate behavior that is professional, ethical, and responsible
- · Perform other reasonable duties and responsibilities as assigned by the Director

Physical Requirements:
