Develop and revise curriculum for a 150-hour CDA Infant/Toddler certification course, aligned with CDA competency standards

Create lesson plans, instructional materials, and assessments

Deliver engaging instruction to adult learners, including synchronous and asynchronous sessions

Ensure course and program learning outcomes are met

Evaluate student progress, maintain attendance and grading records, and submit required documentation
