- Facilitate student assessments and work sampling.

- Guide students in their academic growth.
- Work with parents to promote understanding of the growth and development of their child. Effectively communicate with parents, verbally and in written form, throughout the school year.
- Develop effective communication strategies.
- Work as a supportive team member within the Early Childhood Learning Center and supervise Assistant Teacher, Teacher Aides, and Volunteers.
- Maintain a clean and safe classroom environment by reporting and/or removing all potential hazards and setting up spaces and materials to support children's learning.
- Maintain accurate program documentation, including but not limited to incident/ accident/ behavior reports, attendance sheets, sign-in/ sign-out sheets, development/ growth forms, document eating and sleeping, parent surveys, etc.
