 - CDA credential, relevant college coursework, or NYS teacher certification is a plus.
 - Previous experience working with infants, toddlers, preschoolers, or young children is preferred.
 - Knowledge of child development and developmentally appropriate practices.
 - Caring, dependable, patient, professional, and able to work collaboratively.
 - Effective communication and classroom-management skills.
 - Willingness to complete required training, staff medical clearance, fingerprinting, comprehensive background checks, and reference verification.
 - CPR and First Aid certification preferred or willingness to obtain it within the required timeframe.
